Eleuthère Irénée (E.I.) du Pont (1771-1834), a Frenchman and student of Lavoisier broke ground on July 19, 1802, on the banks of the Delaware river for the company that bears his name.

In its 215 years of existence the company has reinvented itself several times from a gunpowder and explosives manufacturer to a chemicals and materials company to a science and engineering based company. In the course of its history the company marketed products like Teflon®, Nylon®, Kevlar® and Nomex®.

The 2017 merger between DuPont and Dow Chemicals and subsequent split into three separate companies will be the next milestone in the history of the company.

DuPont de Nemours Luxembourg manufactures Mylar® polyester film, Hytrel® thermoplastic elastomer, Typar® spunbonded polypropylene and Tyvek® spunbonded polyethylene.

Paul Meyers will present the exceptional history and the future of the DuPont corporation and what it means for the company's site in Contern, Luxembourg.
